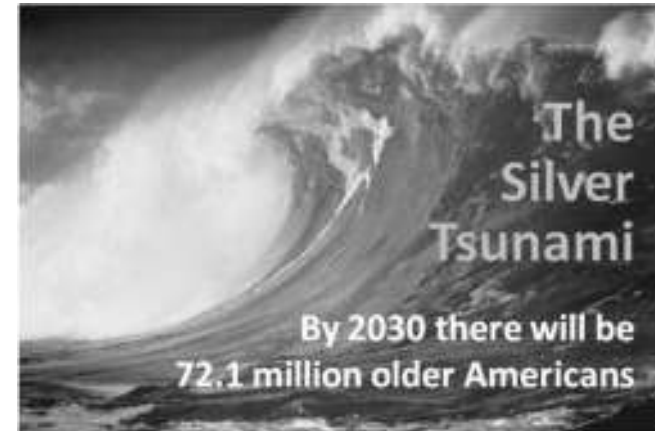

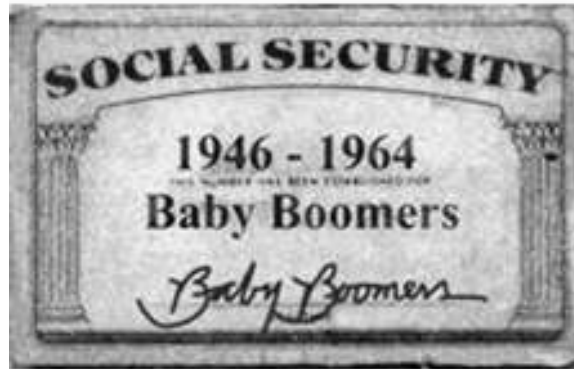
Unlike their parents, many baby boomers see no reason to quit working just because they hit 65--they say age is just a number! In fact, most boomers plan to work past the typical retirement age.
