High Impact Training & Counseling and The Anger Management Institute now provide E-Counseling services (internet counseling) for the treatment and evaluation for substance use disorders, anger management, shoplifting (theft prevention), MRT (Moral Reconciliation Therapy), Marijuana Addiction Treatment and Victim Impact class. Our aim is to address your treatment concerns or needs in a professional and efficient manner.

E-Counseling treatment for addiction removes transportation and geographical obstacles. Also, E-Counseling provides the convenience of participating in counseling from the convenience of your home while removing the stigma that is often associated with coming to an office for help. E-Counseling is an excellent alternative for clients in rural areas of the State who must drive long distances to get to a treatment center or to see an addiction specialist. If you are on probation, parole or court mandated to participate in some type of program, E-Counseling can be a major problem solver for meeting the requirements of probation, parole, or the courts because of the online convenience.

### Easy Access:

To participate in E-Counseling Services, all you need is either a computer, tablet, or smart phone. Sessions are conducted via video conferencing.

### E-Counseling Services:

- Clinical Evaluation/Substance Abuse Evaluation: \$110
- Individual Counseling Sessions: \$60
- Group Counseling Sessions (if enough participants) \$45
- Anger Management Evaluation: \$75
- Anger Management Sessions: \$60
- Shoplifting (Theft Prevention) \$125
- MRT (Moral Reconciliation Therapy) sessions: \$45
- Victim Impact Classes: \$60 for 1 hour

Upon completion of the various programs, a letter will be emailed or faxed to you and faxed or emailed to your referral source.
